


DIVING SINCE 1950



The history of Squale is deeply linked to one man, Mr.Charles Von Buren, who founded in 1946 the "Von Büren S.A. / Montres" in Neuchatel, Switzerland. Squale was literately founded on the shores of Lake Neuchatel where the watches were tested by founder Charles Von Büren himself and even his daughter Monique.

Charles von Büren put all of his energy and ingenuity in developing and fine-tuning his watches and even handed out watches to test by professional coral-fisher and people who worked as professional extreme divers.

This testing and pioneering led to the concept of what we now know nowadays as the modern diving watch. A watch able to withstand the extreme conditions related to the sea, such as high pressure and low temperature.

"Von Büren Montres S.A" started to produce watches and watchcases in 1946 as they saw the need for reliable, safe and elegant dive-watches.

Various large and smaller watch-brands started to use Squale as a specialist supplier for cases and even complete assembled watches, bearing very often the Squale Shark on the dial.

The famous and unique "Von Büren" cases quickly became the blueprint for a modern professional diving watch.

After the first years as a specialist supplier, In the 1950's "Von Büren S.A./ Montres" started to produce their own range of professional dive watches under the Squale brand-name, marking the beginning of the brands institutional history.

In the 1960's Squale introduced the first Squale 1000 meter (100 ATM) with the unique glass on flexible double mountings, which was a unique safety feature and a novelty of great importance.

Squale became the preferred dive watch for world-champions free-diving and spearfishing like Jaques Mayol, Maria Treleani, Jean Tapu, Tony Salvatori and the Cuban national diving team of 1967.

Diving was considered a extreme sport back then and the dive-watch was a necessary part of the safety equipment. A dive watch should be safe and reliable in any condition. Even today this is the brand philosophy of Squale watches. Squale supplied the elite corps of a large number of armed forces, amongst these where the "Folgore Brigade" part of the Italian Air-forces, the Italian Navy's Diving Corps and the French Special naval commandos better know as "bérets verts". All this has made Squale synonymous as a specialist and the benchmark brand for professional dive-watches internationally, a status it still enjoys after decades. Squale watches nowadays has a production facility in the Jura region in Switzerland. Squale watches are Swiss made and assembled by master-watchmakers that take great pride in producing and protecting the Squale legacy of providing reliable, superbly designed and elegant professional dive watches.

60 ATM professional

The Squalematic 60 ATM Professional takes its inspiration from the great Squale designs of the past in a perfectly authentic and respectful way but executed in the more contemporary size of 44 mm diameter.

The Squalematic 60 ATM features the typical Squale crown at the 4 o'clock position which is slightly recessed and well protected against unwanted impact.

The elegant flowing design of the polished and brushed case makes the watch exceptionally comfortable to wear.

The scratch-resistant domed double convex sapphire crystal is enhanced with anti-reflective treatment on both sides protecting this timepiece up to 600 meters below sea-level as well as allowing for perfect legibility without blurring and optical distortion.

This double domed sapphire-crystal gives it a perfect retro look and feel, adding to the uniqueness and special character of the Squalematic.

The watch respects all the core values of a Squale watch being, reliable, elegant, unique, affordable and easy to service.

1521 Bead blasted

Bead blasting is a process of altering the finish of a metal surface by subjecting the surface to a stream of glass beads, or sand, unders high pressure. In this way the surface is "blasted" by the particles, resulting in a durable matte, non-reflective finish.
